Raising the Brine Shrimp to Adulthood

Newly Hatched Brine Shrimp can be raised up to adults that can be fed to older fish. They will also reproduce and can be self-sustaining. A container of 10 gallons or greater is required.

Combine:

1 cup Kosher rock salt per gallon of water 18 tablespoons Epson salt per 10 gallon container 1/4 - 1/2 teaspoon Brine Shrimp cysts

75-82 degrees
Overhead Light on 8-12 hrs. per Day

Place airstone less than 2 inches from surface. No deeper. Feed Spirulina powder (nuts.com) alternate with Baking yeast, not quick acting. Feed just enough to cloud water slightly, only feed after water has cleared, about 2- 3 days.

Shrimp will reproduce by birthing and releasing cysts that will accumulate at the water line. Occasional water changes are recommended, with water prepared of the same salt and Epsom salt concentrations.
