Freezing the Shrimp for Future Use

Place the container with the newly hatched shrimp and fresh tap or aquarium water directly into the freezer for 45-55 minutes. Do not freeze. If allowed to fully freeze, the Shrimp must be thawed and used all at once.

The near freezing will cause the shrimp to sink, and remaining cyst shells will float to the top. The shrimp will have sunken into a fairly cyst-shell free, thick orange slurry on the bottom of the container.

With a turkey baster, fill ice cube trays about half full with the shrimp, and top off with water. Then place the trays in the freezer and fully freeze.

One batch from this hatcher will yield 1- 1.5 standard ice cube trays of BBS.
